SUPPRESSING POA ANNUA A PRIORITY

pring has been a roller coaster of weather with some very warm days and also some below freezing days. This pattern has limited the soil temperature, which in turn has limited the turfgrass growth.

The ground's crew has been busy with clean-up of winter debris around the course.

On March 13, we applied our first application of growth regulators to suppress the poa annua seedhead populations on the greens. This greatly reduces the amount of seedheads and improves the consistency of the greens during the time when poa annua seeds the most.

We have a few small projects planned for this spring which include painting the new porta-potty screens, sod the area behind 18 green where the new culvert went in, fine tune our new irrigation boxes, and apply our pre-emergence crabgrass control.

The ground's crew is looking forward to a great golf season and can't wait to get going!



When using golf carts on the golf course, please adhere to our golf cart policies to keep our golf course and golf carts in good condition. When the golf course is cart path only, please keep your golf carts on the cart path. The last thing any of us want to do is push a golf cart out of the mud. If the golf course is too wet, not only can golf carts get stuck, but also they can leave tire tracks in the soft ground that can stick around for a while and
