From the Course

GOLF COURSE GOOD DESPITE ALL THE RAIN

As the month of August begins, I normally talk about the hot, dry weather we usually experience this time of year, but the forecast for the next several weeks shows cooler than normal temperatures. This is a welcome respite that should allow for some healing of the fairways from the monsoon-like period we experienced from late June through July. In one 35 day period, we measured nearly 18 inches of rain.

Through the extremely wet period, the golf course has remained in good condition.

Greens, tees and approach areas are excellent. Fairways have been

very good also only marred by a few wet areas that held water for days on end. Grass, like all other plants, needs to be able to access oxygen in the root zone. Saturated soils fill all the pore spaces with water, cutting off the oxygen, resulting in plant death.

In the next few weeks, we will be out filling and seeding multiple low areas that are easily identified now. We also have an agreement with the Shelbourne Green HOA to fix the drainage on the west side of the 12th hole. We will fill and seed the parts of the course that were damaged by the standing water.

As always, please remember to replace or fill divots, repair your ballmarks, rake the sand when you are done in the bunkers, and be responsible with golf cars and push carts. By the way, when water is over the cart path, it is far better to drive slowly through the water on the path than the grass adjacent to the path.

AUGUST LAWN TIP: Any areas that need to be seeded can be done any time. Mow with a sharp blade. Begin broadleaf spraying toward the end of the month.
